	1		SUNDAY, CONFERENCE WITH C.O. WITH ALL OFFICERS WHEN MATTERS RE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT REVIEWED AS FOLLOWS: GREAT NEED FOR SHOES; LACK OF SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF KILTS AND UNIFORMS. IT WAS NOTED THAT THE LOCAL RED CROSS AND SALVATION ARMY HAD HELPED MATERIALLY IN LOANING SHOES AND SUPPLYING SOCKS. IT WAS DECIDED THAT (1) THE TIME HAD NOW COME TO DRAW UP TRAINING SYLLABUS COVERING A PROGRESSIVE SCHEME OF TRAINING AND THE SECOND-IN-COMMAND WAS APPOINTED TO TAKE CARE OF THIS IN COLLABORATION WITH R.S.M. 	OCTOBER 9		THANKSGIVING DAY - HOLIDAY - NO PARADE; OFFICERS, DETAILS AND STAFF ONLY REPORTING FOR DUTY. AT A CONFERENCE O. C. AND OFFICERS PROGRESS OF TRAINING REVIEWED AND QUESTION OF DISCIPLINE. ALL OFFICERS AGREED DISCIPLINE WAS EXTREMELY DIFFICULT TO ENFORCE WITH MEN LIVING IN BILLETS AT VARIOUS PLACES IN THE CITY. IT WAS CONCLUDED THE MOST THAT COULD BE DONE WAS TO BRING OUR PROBLEMS TO ATTENTION OF PROPER AUTHORITY WITH SUGGESTION THAT BARRACKS FOR UNIT WOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE; THAT IN THE MEANTIME OFFICERS AND N.C.O.'S SHOULD MAINTAIN FULL DISCIPLINE DURING PARADE HOURS AND TRY THROUGH MILITARY POLICE TO RESTRICT INFRACTIONS OF MILITARY CONDUCT DURING OFF-PARADE HOURS; ALSO THROUGH BILLETS OFFICER ARRANGING FOR PERIODIC INSPECTION OF BILLETS, AND INTERVIEWING LANDLORDS. I WAS ALSO DECIDED THAT A COURSE OF LECTURES BE GIVEN THE N. C. O.'S AT THE MARKETORIUM BUILDING IN THE EVENING COVERING SUBJECTS OF GENERAL MILITARY KNOWLEDGE.	7/14
